Synopsis: An Officer was conducting an extra patrol of the Northwood Estates subdivision due to recent auto burglaries. As he drove by a home in the 2800 block of Saber Dr, he noticed both doors to a vehicle parked in the driveway were open. He requested additional units and K-9 to the scene. While checking the neighborhood, a second auto burglary was discovered in the 2400 block of Parkstream Ave. **Both vehicles were left unlocked.** It appears the Officer came into the area about the time the first vehicle was being burglarized, as a lot of valuable items inside the car were not taken. There was nothing reported stolen out of the 2<sup>nd</sup> vehicle either.

**Update:** The victim reported that an unknown suspect entered his RV/Camper by force and once inside the suspect stole a DVD, stereo, TV/VCR, and power tools valued at \$600.00. Detectives were notified that a suspect, Mitchell Huston, was identified by forensic evidence found at the scene of the burglary. On 05/04/10, the suspect was located at county jail on similar charges and Detectives added the Burglary and Grand Theft charges

Suspect's: Two B/M 's 18-20 yoa. Black shorts, black t-shirts. One male with short dreads.  
Synopsis: The victim picked up the suspect's in the area of Roosevelt Blvd. & Alma Avenue, as he was driving his United Cab. The suspect's requested a ride to the area of Sunset Point Rd. and Kings Hwy. They then directed him to the area of Douglas Ave. and Russell Street. One of the suspects held a knife to his throat and demanded his money. The victim handed the suspect's \$ 90.00 cash before the suspect cut the left side of his neck. The suspects punched him several times on the right side of his face and the back of his head as he tried to reach back and grab them. Both suspect's exited the rear of the cab and ran in a southbound direction.

Charges: 2 counts Felon in Poss. Firearm, S+P Marijuana, 2 counts Poss. Controlled Substance  
Seized: .38 revolver (reported lost/stolen), .22 revolver, 5 ounces marijuana, xanax tablets

Synopsis: Detectives received information that Haggard was in possession of a firearm which he wanted to sell and was also actively involved in narcotics sales. Haggard was determined to be a convicted felon and the .38 handgun was subsequently purchased from him. Additional investigation continued into Haggard's activities, which resulted in Haggard selling two ounces of marijuana and a .22 revolver to Detectives on this date, culminating in his arrest. Officers responded to Haggard's residence and located appx. 3 ounces of marijuana, xanax tablets and drug paraphernalia in Haggard's bedroom. Haggard admitted to all of these offenses and was charged accordingly.
