Synopsis: Officers were conducting a Park Walk and Talk in the above area in reference to obtaining additional intelligence pertaining to a drug case. They were approached by a concerned citizen. This citizen handed them a clear baggie with 42 grams of marijuana inside of it. The citizen had located the bag on the side of the road in the area of Zara Way and Merlin Dr. Officers continued talking to other citizens in the area and were able to obtain information pertaining to narcotics activity at a residence in the 2700 block of Tasha Dr. A knock and talk was conducted at which time the above listed subjects were found to be in possession of 419 grams of marijuana.

Crime Prevention Tip: Understand that once a criminal has the electronic key fob that most vehicles now have, they can drive or walk through a parking lot with the button depressed and see which car responds by a beep and its lights going on. Once they identify it they can steal from it or steal the vehicle itself. They can also look at the registration and see where you live. Since you are at the beach, maybe no one is home and they could go burglarize your home. It's the rolling snowball effect. So, protect that fob!
