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WHY: On November 9, 2009, Clearwater Police Department Traffic Homicide Investigators presented their investigative findings to the Pinellas-Pasco State Attorney's Office. At the conclusion, probable cause for the suspect's arrest was determined for DUI Manslaughter. Clearwater Police arrested the suspect, Thomas Corbin, who was picked up at his home with the assistance of the St. Petersburg Police Department at approximately 12:30 a.m. this morning.

Crash Synopsis:

On September 24, 2009, at approximately 11:50 p.m., a 2005 Toyota pickup truck driven by Corbin was traveling eastbound on Gulf to Bay Boulevard (SR 60). There was a 1999 Nissan stopped at the Gulf to Bay Boulevard and Hampton Road intersection. The Toyota, driven by Corbin, ran into the rear of the Nissan. All three occupants of the Nissan sustained serious injuries in the crash and were transported to local hospitals. Maxwell Limonick, a right rear passenger succumbed to injuries related to the crash on October 2, 2009. The other two occupants' injuries are non-life threatening.

Corbin's Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) was .20. Impairment is presumed at .08.

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
